### Non-Uniform Days

1. Leggings or skin-tight jeans/pants are only acceptable IF WORN UNDER a skirt/dress or article of clothing that comes no higher than approximately 2" above the knee. Sweaters/cardigans will not count as an over shirt for leggings or skin-tight jeans/pants, unless it can be completely buttoned or closed up and the sweater/cardigan hangs no higher than approximately 2" above the knee. The expectation will be that the sweater/cardigan will be worn buttoned or closed up during the school day.
2. Students are not allowed to wear the following on non-uniform days:
  - a. Torn clothing - even if there is an under layer to the tear.
  - b. Short skirts or shorts (must be no higher than approximately 2" above the knee)
  - c. T-shirts with inappropriate slogans or logos
  - d. Shirts with midriff, spaghetti straps, or undergarments showing
  - e. Slogans across the seat of pants/shorts/skirt

### The Shirt Day and Theme Day

1. Non-uniform days are held periodically throughout the year. Clothing worn for dress-up days must be no more revealing than the school uniform.
2. On special theme days, students are expected to either participate in the theme day or wear the normal school uniform.
