Hello Crusader Families!

Sorry this week's edition of *The Crusader: A "Brief Viau"* is late. We had a very productive Professional Development Day on Friday with our Staff, which led to the postponement of our weekly communication. On Friday the Staff was blessed with training from Father Ryan Ford on our new Religious curriculum and Safe Environment lessons. In the next few weeks, your child(ren) will be learning grade and age appropriate lessons on how to stay safe from predators. If you do not want your child to participate in these lessons, please reach out to your child's teacher. When your child's teacher teaches these lessons, then your child will come to the office to do other work, but please keep in mind that these lessons are age and grade appropriate and also approved by the Diocese of Marquette. The Staff also had time to collaborate with each other, received some Classical training from our very own Headmaster, Mrs. Viau, Google Training from Mr. Derkos, and we started our yearlong spiritual professional development through Franciscan at Home.

I'd like to give a friendly reminder that school **starts** at 8:10am at the Grade School for Middle School students and 8:15am for PreK-5th grade students. Please have your students to school no later than these start times so they can head to class with their peers. Also as a reminder for High School students, school starts at 7:45am.

We have been working hard on improving our communication with parents and thanks to the hard work and dedication of Mr. Derkos, we now have a texting communication tool set up through FACTS. It will work very similar to how you receive emails currently, but if it's a short message that we can blast out faster through text, we will. It is limited in characters, so please still continue to check your email for longer messages or messages with attachments, such as *The Crusader: A "Brief Viau.* We will roll out a text test on Tuesday morning. As Parent Teacher Conferences are approaching, I'd like to remind parents to first reach out to teachers with any questions or concerns before coming to Mrs. Viau or I. If you have tried working with the teacher and you are still having concerns, then please reach out to one of us. If you have any questions or concerns regarding either of the schools, please reach out directly to Mrs. Viau or myself so that we can help you. Reaching out directly to us ensures that we hear your concerns correctly rather than the information accidentally getting lost in translation or misconstrued through third parties.

Finally this week is a reminder that students should not be texting teachers, coaches, or any staff member. As part of VIRTUS and Safe Environment, if your child needs to contact one of our teachers outside of school hours, they should be doing it through email or through parents. When emailing, they should also include a parent so that there isn't any one-on-one outside communication between students and staff. Our Coaches will be working with Mr. Derkos on an app communication so that everyone can be aware of events while making sure we are keeping our students and staff safe. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
